



VISITING SUPPORTERS INFORMATION



Tickets

It is advisable to purchase tickets in advance, usually online or through the visiting club. Tickets on the day are available to purchase only if the original allocation has not been sold before the day of the match.

If you are purchasing on the day, then these can be bought from the ticket office shown on the picture below. We do not accept cash payments on the day.

All visiting supporters are seated in the Holker Street End with standing tickets are alongside the main stand. The maximum away capacity is 662

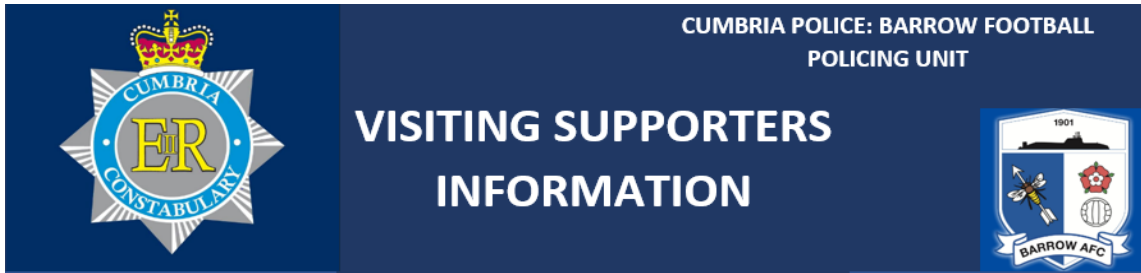
All persons seeking entrance to the Stadium must acknowledge the Club's right to search any person entering, and to refuse entry to or eject any person refusing to undertake a search. This is supported by the police.

Getting to Holker Street Stadium

Whether you are travelling from the North or South on the M6, leave the motorway at Junction 36, which is signposted for Barrow.

Continue to follow the signposts for Barrow and the journey will take around 30-40 minutes from this point.

When you arrive on Park Road, Barrow, you will see the Fire Station on your right with an immediate left turn ahead. Take this left turn and the Stadium is immediately on the right.



Parking

Official Buses can be accommodated around the ground if police have prior knowledge of how many coaches are travelling, to ensure that the space is reserved. The initial bus parking is marked with **X** on the picture below.

There is very limited car parking at the "Soccer Bar" which is just before the stadium.

Please avoid parking at Asda due to the fact it is for patrons only, there is also a parking eye in operation.

By Train

Once you arrive at Barrow train station, if you turn right onto Holker Street, The Progression Law Stadium is only a five-minute walk up the road. The away turnstiles are on the left just after the traffic lights at the end of the road.

Places to eat and drink

Designated away pub- The Newton Public House is located in Dalton-in-Furness. It is only a 10-minute drive to the stadium and has ample parking for busses and cars.



Dalton train station is only a 5-minute walk from here also. Extremely welcoming for away supporters. Paul and the team there are more than happy to accommodate you on your visit. Use postcode LA15 8LS

Ulverston Town Centre.

Ulverston is a popular small market town, around a 20-minute drive from the stadium. There are numerous public Houses at this location but parking for busses can be an issue. Ringing up and giving the heads up to these Public Houses prior to your arrival is recommended, so they can accommodate you.



The Furness Railway (Wetherspoons) is located just outside of Barrow railway station, on Abbey Road.

Parking at this location is non-existent.
